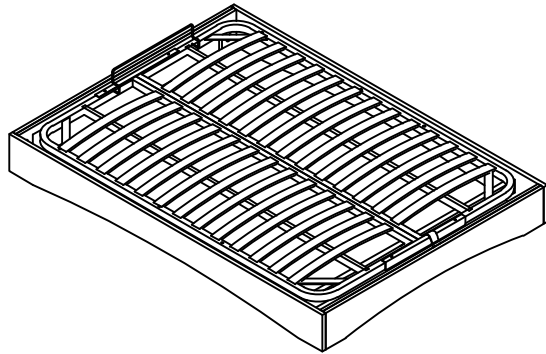

A. The Lift Mechanism assists in raising the mattress on the base but doesn't lift it for you. It works with various mattress weights and depths.

Maximum lift weight (including mattress & bedding): 80kg for King

B. After installation, lift/pull the base up and down a few times to loosen the system. Gas Springs may be stiff initially or after long periods of inactivity. The mattress must be attached to the base.

C. Use two hands to lift and lower the mattress base, evenly spaced from the centre of Front Board. Avoid pulling down on one side to prevent damage or failure of the base and lift mechanism. Always ensure the mattress is fitted before using the lift mechanism.

CAUTION:

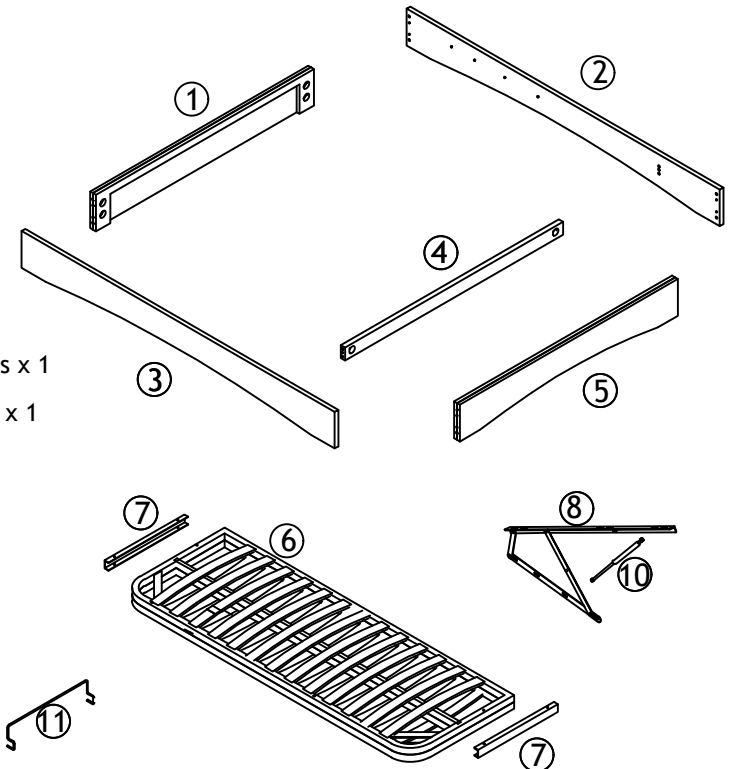
- Children must not operate the lift mechanism or be near the lift base during operation.
- Ensure children and pets stay away from the internal storage base area.
- Keep hands away from the mechanism while operating the base system.
- Do not stand inside the bed or on the internal storage base.
- Avoid overloading the internal storage base.

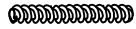

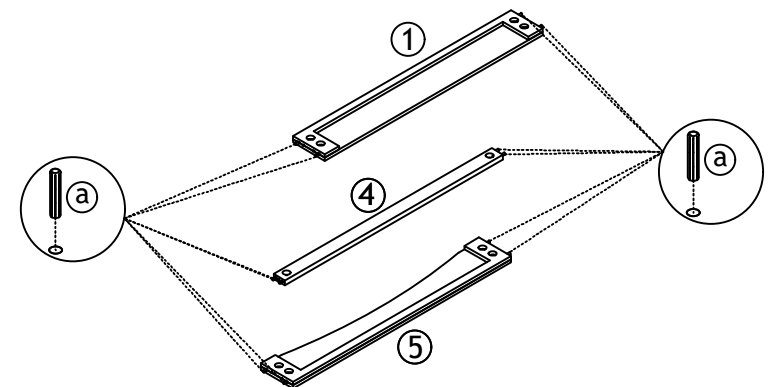
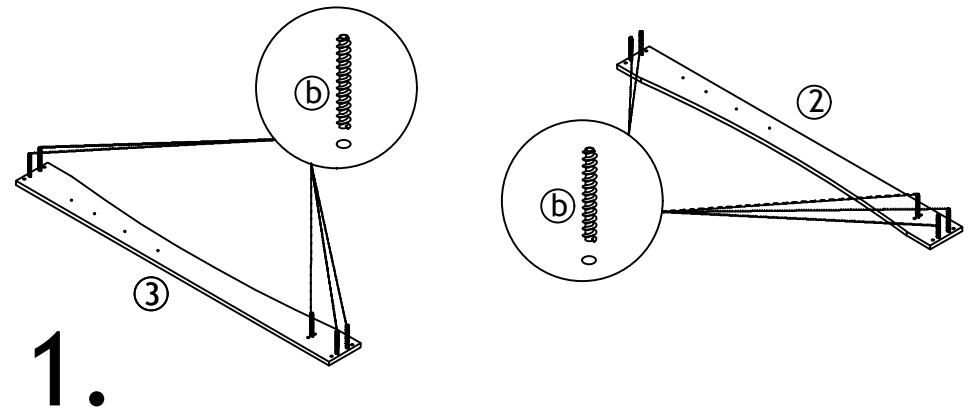

To prevent scratching: Lay the parts face down on a clean, flat, soft surface.



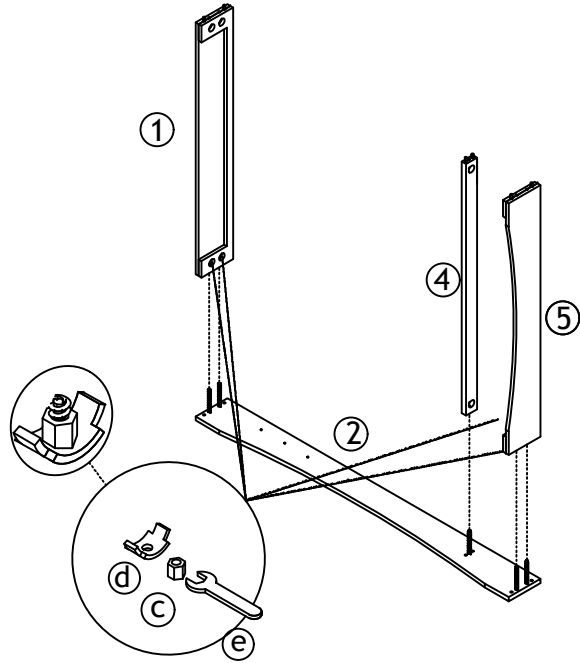

How To Use

Please read carefully

After installation, lift/pull the base up and down a few times to loosen the system. Gas Springs may be stiff initially or after long periods of inactivity. The mattress must be attached to the base.

Use two hands to lift and lower the mattress base, evenly spaced from the centre of Front Board. Avoid pulling down on one side to prevent damage or failure of the base and lift mechanism. Always ensure the mattress is fitted before using the lift mechanism.

FINISH

Your Bed is made from solid Oak and Metal.

CARE

To clean your Bed, wipe with a damp cloth followed by a dry cloth.

IMPORTANT

To ensure maximum performance from this product, we advise that you check and tighten all bolts and screws on a regular basis to avoid damage and strain to parts.
