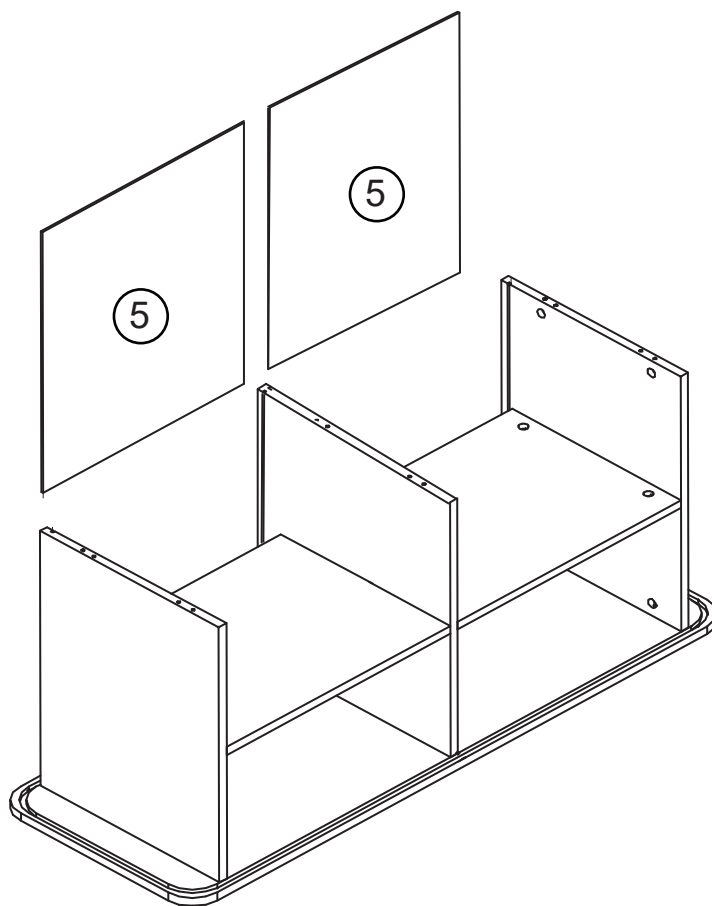
1. To prevent scratching: Lay the top face down on a clean, flat, soft surface.



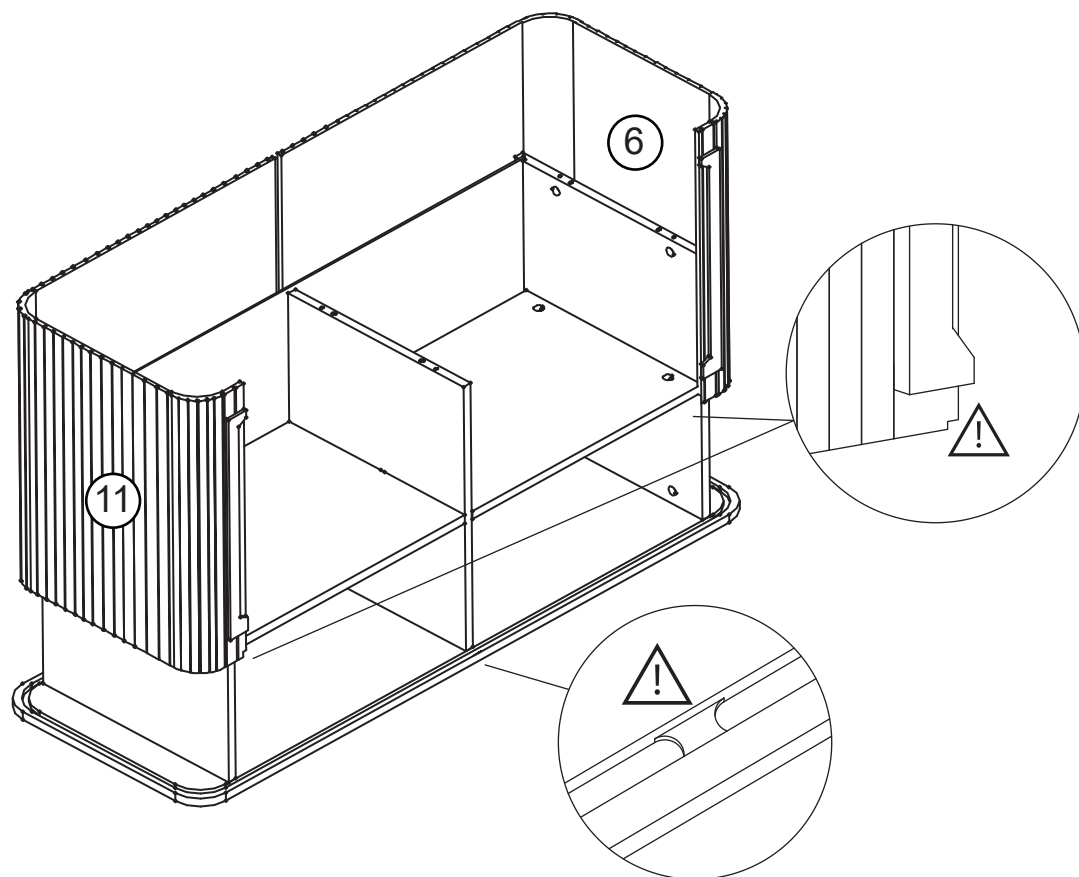
